




















# Tamit Christmas CAROL SERVICE

## The Precious "Peace Be With You"

Dear Friends / Brothers and Sisters.

I'm (Aunty Balasingham) here to write about aging and how to face it in Faith and Perseverance. I'm 70 years old facing challenges in health and life like you and others. I know that life is not easy but with Christ Jesus everything is possible. Philippians 4:1 (KJV) I can do all things through Christ which strengthen me.

What does the Bible say about aging? Aging in the Bible is said to be a sign of experience. The Lord promises His continuous love and concern for the elderly. "I will be your God throughout your lifetime until your hair is white with age. I made you, and I will care for you. What a promising word. Amen, He is with us, so fear not. Face it by trusting His promise.

Even to your old age and gray hairs

I am he, I am he who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you. Isaiah 46:4 (NIV)

When I was 30 didn't bother me. Neither did 40 or even 50 nor 60. But birthday #69 this past 2017 December was a tough one for me. For the first time in my life, I felt old. And a little insecure.

If you're in the 60+ category like I am, there's no going back. And looking beyond to 70 or 80 can make you feel a little uneasy, can't it? But today, as I was having my quiet time reading His Word, God spoke to me so beautifully. In fact, He encouraged this 69-year-old woman so much that I can't wait to share it with all of my 50+ year old friends.

I wonder, could that possibly be YOU?

I have heard many people balk at their age, lie about their age, joke about "forever 29". I never got it. I mean, age means credibility. Age means another year of life that God has blessed you with. Hallelujah! However, I recently turned 70. And I think I'm beginning to understand those reservations about aging. The thought that I'm nearly three quarter a century old and I now have fewer days in front of me than behind me is quite mellowing. Since I prefer to look at every situation as an opportunity to grow, let me share with you two things I already appreciate about turning 70. 1. Wisdom and experience come at a cost. With that in mind, I would rather be the age I am now than to be fumbling through my 20s and 30s again, still trying to figure out life, still needing to learn the lessons God has already taught me, and still making the mistakes I no longer want to repeat. Thank you, God, for lessons learned, experiences gained, and wisdom that comes through living life. Proverbs 3:13 (NIV) Blessed are those who find wisdom, those who gain understanding, 2. There is an urgency to living wisely and well. Now that there are fewer days in front of me than behind me, how I live from this moment on shapes my eternity even more than it ever did before. Will mine be aneternity of rewards andblessings, or a quiet disappointment that I hadn't lived more for Christ and less for myself? Thank you, God, for reminders that I am mortal and that I am to number my days that I may present to you a heart ofwisdom. Psalm 90:12 (NIV) Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom. Our life spanmay be 70 years but 80 years may be due to our strength which will be in pain.

Psalm 90:10 (NIV) Our days may come to seventy years, or eighty, if our strength endures; yet the best of them are but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away.

#### Dear friends,

I bring Christmas greetings to you all and wish you a happy and blessed New Year 2019

As we are in the festive season, I would like to remind everyone about the importance of giving. The Bible mentions in various places of the different

principles and attitudes to giving which should be practiced,

here I'll mention a few;

1. Give freely; Matthew 10:8 "Freely you received, freely give." This verse reminds me of all the blessings I have received from God freely, God gave His only begotten son for our sins and He died to save us. To give freely, is to give without expectations. This may be hard as we want to benefit from giving or obtain a reward, however the real reward of selflessly giving is joy and eternal blessing and that's the greatest reward you can receive.

2. Secondly, in Matthew 6:3-4 it says, 'But when you give to the poor, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving will be secret; and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you." This means don't give with an ulterior motive, where you'll gain private benefits. In an era of showcasing or everyday lives on all social media platforms, it is difficult for many to give confidentially as they seek to give to look good in front of others or have temporal recognition. Giving in secret keeps others from judging us, comparing with us, applauding us, and we them. So remember to give in private!

- 3. Thirdly, we should have the correct motive and mind set when giving. This means to give with a cheerful heart and mind. In 2 Corinthians 9:7 it says God loves a 'cheerful giver.' A cheerful giver should be eager, ready, willing and most importantly prepared to give.
- 4. Lastly, be encouraged as when we give (what we sow), we will reap. 2 Corinthians 9:6 'Whoever sows generously will also reap generously.' We reap proportionately to what we sow, so when we plant many seeds, likewise we'll harvest many seeds.
